REFLECT

In the drama of the last days, the Lord is never without a witness. A witness is someone who shares, not only with words, but also with their very lives, who the Lord is. God calls all of us to be His witnesses. This is why we have been sealed and empowered by the Holy Spirit. But in the last days, God uses some very unique witnesses to point people to Him. We will meet this in this weekend's message.

REALIZE

1. Be a witness

- Scripture Reference; Acts 1:8
- Leader Notes
 - God calls and empowers us to be witnesses for Jesus in the world as we live and work.
 - God wants us to allow him to show himself through our faithfulness and fruitfulness.
- Questions for Reflection
 - What is my testimony to the world about Jesus?

2. Death & resurrection is how God works

- Scripture Reference; John 12:24-25
- Leader Notes
 - Jesus calls us to live lives of resurrection, dying to self and living for Him.
- Questions for Reflection
 - How can I grow to be a better witness?

3. Proclaim God's kingdom

- Scripture Reference; Romans 10:14-15
- Leader Notes
 - The kingdom of God is proclaimed and now will be experienced on earth.
 - Your words and your life should proclaim the truth of God's kingdom.
- Questions for reflection
 - How can I engage more deeply in seeking God's kingdom?

Optional Follow-up Questions:

- What makes you say that?
- How do you feel about that?
- How would you explain your answer to a non-Christian friend or neighbor?
- Why did God design it to work that way? Why not just do (whatever else) instead?
- What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
- Why do we really have to do it like that? Why can't we just go (some other route) instead?
