REFLECT

There are many unique attributes of God. We love to talk about God's omniscience and omnipotence. We love to talk about God's holiness and love. Yet, we almost never talk about the unique vulnerability of God. In fact, the words vulnerability and God seem to have little to do with each other. Yet, the Bible teaches us something completely different. The incarnation of Jesus shows God's great and profound vulnerability.

We will begin our Christmas series by looking at Jesus in vulnerability as He is tempted by Satan at the beginning of His ministry. We will learn not only about Jesus, but also about ourselves.

- Why did God design it to work that way? Why not just do (whatever else) instead?
- What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
- Why do we really have to do it like that? Why can't we just go (some other route) instead?
