REFLECT

2. Armor up

- **Scripture Reference;** 1 Peter 5:8-9
- **Questions for Reflection**
 - Where are there weaknesses in my armor?

3. Pray for everyone

- **Scripture Reference;** Isaiah 38:9-22
- **Questions for reflection**
 - How can I grow deeper in prayer?
 - Who is God calling me to pray for and invite to come with me to church?

Optional Follow-up Questions:

- What makes you say that?
- How do you feel about that?
- How would you explain your answer to a non-Christian friend or neighbor?
- Why did God design it to work that way? Why not just do (whatever else) instead?
- What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
- Why do we really have to do it like that? Why can't we just go (some other route) instead?
