REFLECT

- Scripture Reference; Galatians 3:27
- Questions for reflection
 - What areas of my life is God restoring as son/daughter in his family?

- What makes you say that?
- How do you feel about that?
- How would you explain your answer to a non-Christian friend or neighbor?
- Why did God design it to work that way? Why not just do (whatever else) instead?
- What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
- Why do we really have to do it like that? Why can't we just go (some other route) instead?
