REFLECT

So much of life is experienced in a specific place. Think of the home that you grew up in, or the town that you live in now. We all have a unique sense of place. REALIZE

1. God's presence is vigorous

- Scripture Reference; Psalms 23:6; Ephesians 2:4-6; Psalm 136:1
- Leader Notes
 - Surely, without a doubt, God's presence will continue with me
 - Do you look forward to the future with hope and expectancy or dread and fear?
 - We need to remember that God's presence is vigorous in the hardships, in the waiting, and at all times
- Questions for Reflection
 - What characteristics of God are the most profound to me?

2. God's promises are eternal

- Scripture Reference; Psalms 23:6; 1 John 2:24-25; John 3:16-17
- Leader Notes
 - You need to make choices now and today that future you will appreciate
 - "To be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord"
 - The promise we have in Jesus is eternal life
- Questions for Reflection
 - How can I better embrace eternity?

3. God's house is where we belong

- Scripture Reference; Psalms 23:6; Psalm 27:4; John 15:4-5
- Leader Notes
 - \circ $\;$ In God's house is where we belong, and where we should long to be
- Questions for reflection
 - What would it look like for me to abide in Jesus?

Optional Follow-up Questions:

- What makes you say that?
- How do you feel about that?
- How would you explain your answer to a non-Christian friend or neighbor?
- Why did God design it to work that way? Why not just do (whatever else) instead?
- What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
- Why do we really have to do it like that? Why can't we just go (some other route) instead?
