REFLECT

In Acts 8, we see great revival following the preaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ by the deacon Philip. And yet, we also see deliberate deception carried out by Simon the Sorcerer, a prideful and selfish man. This section highlights the distinction between genuine faith and self-seeking motives. How can we best discern wise counsel from dangerous doctrine? What are the implications of attempting to manipulate the ministry of the Holy Spirit? How can we best ensure that we are carefully and genuinely seeking God's will and the Holy Spirit's leading? Join us as we look at the power of the Holy Spirit and the dangers of seeking spiritual gifts for personal gain.
