Outline: Recap Points to Ponder Questions to draw out understanding.

REFLECT

God works in mysterious ways. That is not only a pithy phrase. It is a biblical reality. We are continually reminded that God's thoughts are higher than our thoughts and that God's ways are better than our ways. Now imagine if you were Philip, the great evangelist of the early church, and the Spirit invited you to leave a revival in Samaria to head out on a desert road. Would you protest? Would you doubt it? - Why did God design it to work that way? Why not just do (whatever else) instead?
- What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
- Why do we really have to do it like that? Why can't we just go (some other route) instead?
