REFLECT

- Questions for Reflection

2. Live a worthy testimony

- Scripture Reference: Acts 20, 2 Corinthians 3:1-3
- Questions for Reflection
 - What can I learn from Paul's exhortation to the Ephesian elders?

3. Take heed, watch, and remember

- Scripture Reference: Acts 20, Proverbs 4:23
- Questions for Reflection
 - Where do I need to cultivate a more pronounced testimony?

Optional Follow-up Questions:

- What makes you say that?
- How do you feel about that?
- How would you explain your answer to a non-Christian friend or neighbor?
- Why did God design it to work that way? Why not just do (whatever else) instead?
- What would you say to someone who disagrees with that?
- Why do we really have to do it like that? Why can't we just go (some other route) instead?
